Happy spring.**

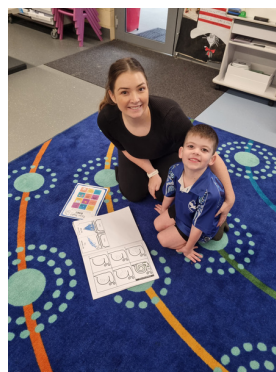
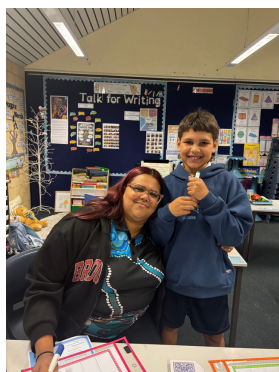
